Parent Responsibilities

We, as parents, will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- Familiarizing myself with PowerSchool and frequently monitoring grades and assignments through this portal;
- Make myself available for communication via email or phone;
- Make sure my child has the necessary school supplies and is ready for school each morning including computer, printer and necessary items for studies;
- Monitor my child's attendance for both in person and online sessions if required;
- Make sure that homework/projects/ are completed as assigned;
- Volunteer at my child's classroom and or school;
- Participate, as appropriate, in decisions relating to my children's education.
- Promote positive use of my child's extracurricular time;
- Stay informed about my child's education and communicate with the school by promptly reading all notices from the school or the school district either received by my child, email, website or by mail and responding, as appropriate;

- Check email daily for immediate communication between home and school;
- Update front office /administration of changes in address, phone numbers and email.
